- (a) All reporting shall be made in A3 size drawing paper [that may be mounted on A2 boards/chart paper for presentations]
- (b) Report should be as analytical in nature as possible
- (c) Case Study shall make an analysis of (i) literature (ii) existing buildings/ complexes of with similar functional, technical or design complexity and problem (iii) study of existing buildings and designs as related to part of the thesis problem (iv) regional/ethnic studies on style, construction and arts and other (v) technical studies. The student work may include all or some of the above cases as instructed/advised during the first review.
- (d) Analysis of site.
- (e) The presentation sheets shall be composed with drawings, sketches, photographs and write-ups as needed and the lettering shall be such as to allow reduction into A4 sheets for inclusion into thesis report later.
- (f) All sheets shall have a title and carry the name of the project and student.
- (g) Students will also submit a final Thesis Proposal on the date of their presentation of Case Study and Research.

This review session will be marked out of 100. Marks for thesis proposal will be awarded out of 25 marks. Previous works on thesis proposal and case studies have been allocated 25 and 50 marks respectively.
